Only those compounds that need to have a longer period between last treatment and slaughter (an ESI) to comply with export market requirements are shown above.

(b) APVMA Permit 10115, that managed the phaseout of use of dimetridazole in pigs, expired in July 2009. Following expiry of this permit, dimetridazole is not permitted for use in pigs.
